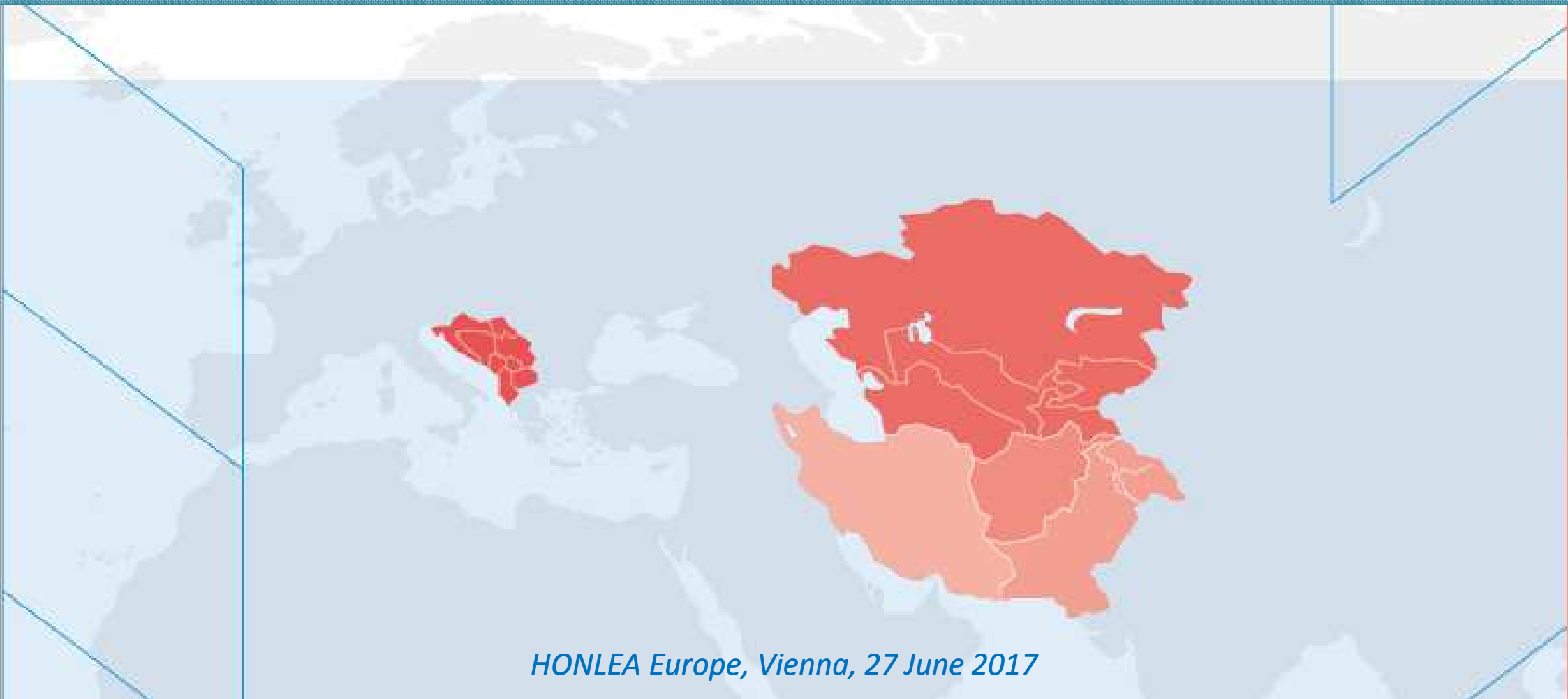

Strategic tool to support the region in the implementation of relevant United Nations treaties and instruments in line with EU requirements under chapters 23, 24 and 28 of the EU acquis



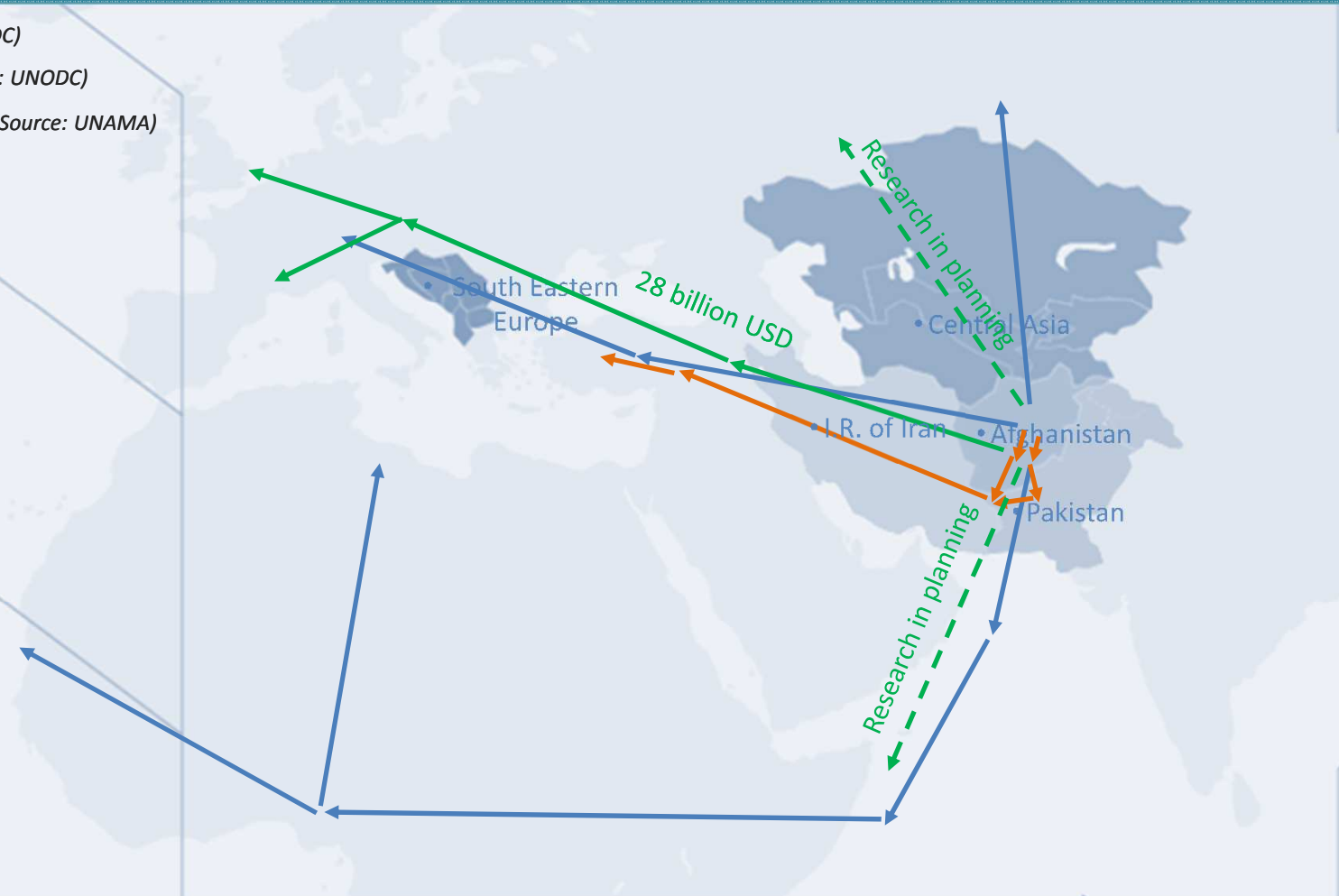

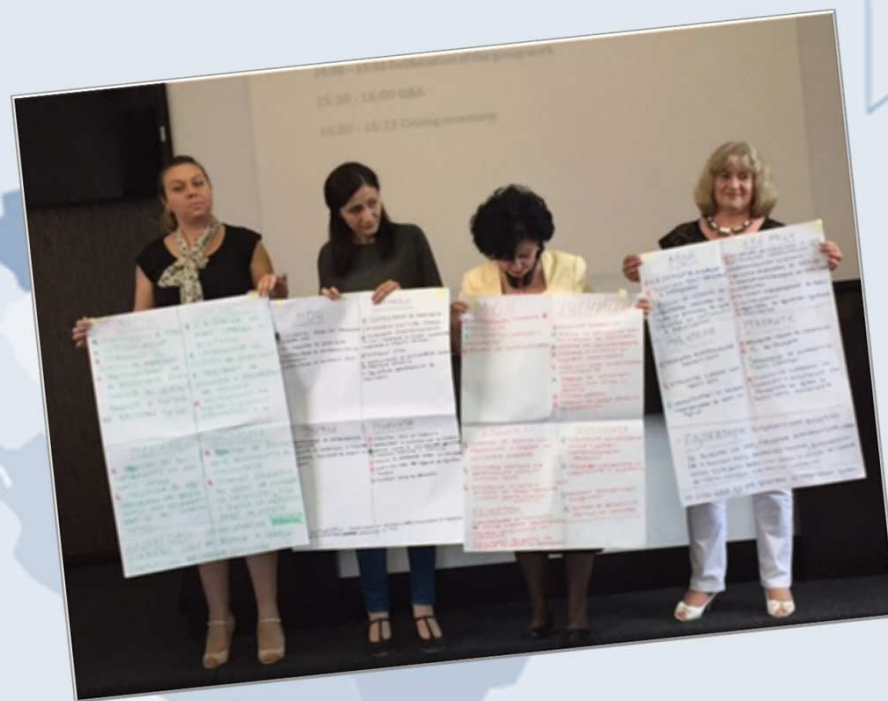


Results of prevention programme: Serbia, Montenegro, the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia
