About the Portal

In its resolution 7/1, entitled Strengthening the implementation of the United Nations Convention against Transnational Organized Crime and the Protocols thereto, the Conference of the Parties invited State Parties and, on a voluntary basis, other interested Member States, to provide information on the relevant legislative tools to be included in the knowledge management portal known as Sharing Electronic Resources and Laws on Crime.

Furthermore in resolution 7/3, the United Nations Office on Office on Drugs and Crime was asked to continue to work on the knowledge management portal known as Sharing Electronic Resources and Laws on Crime, building on the work accomplished in the development of the digest of organized crime cases.

Case Law Database

A comprehensive database containing jurisprudence, which allows users to see how Member States are tackling criminal cases in their courts.

Database of Legislation

An electronic repository of national laws relevant to the provisions of the Convention, searchable by country, Convention article, crime type and cross-cutting issues.

Bibliographic Database

An annotated bibliography providing synopses of key articles that are searchable by country, research methods and keywords.

CNA Directory

A directory of competent national authorities designated to receive, respond to and process requests pertaining to mutual legal assistance, extradition and transfer of sentenced prisoners, smuggling of migrants, trafficking in firearms and trafficking in cultural property.



Fourteen specific types of crime are currently covered in SHERLOC



Cross-cutting issues include special procedures and provisions of the Convention that facilitate the effective investigation and prosecution of transnational organized crime, such as extradition, mutual legal assistance, joint investigative bodies or special investigative techniques.
